

## IAA STATE OUTDOOR TARGET CHAMPIONSHIP 900 ROUND

**The Tournament Committee will handle the advertising for the tournament.**

**For a two-day tournament:**

**The first day's shooting time will be at 10:00 a.m.**

**The second day's shooting time will be at 9:00 a.m.**

**For a one-day tournament:**

**Both day's shooting time will be at 10:00 a.m.**

**The following information must be supplied to the Tournament Committee Chair for publication:**

**Directions to range**

**Area accommodations (motels, camping)**

**Club contact name and phone number for further assistance with directions and accommodations.**

### **REQUIREMENTS:**

The Host Club must provide enough target bales to accommodate no more than 5 archers per bale (no more than 4 archers per bale is preferred).

The host club must furnish an adult to chaperone cub shooters – one for every four cubs.

**OFFICIAL TARGET FACES ARE TO BE USED FOR THE TOURNAMENT.**

Provide drinking water at a minimum of each 10 targets.

**TARGET RANGE LAY OUT, TARGET BALE AND TARGET BACK STOPS SHOULD FOLLOW RULES AS SPECIFIED IN THE CURRENT NFAA HANDBOOK FOR THE NFAA 810 & 900 TARGET ROUND.**
