The IAA Board of Directors and Delegates meeting was held March 14, 2010 at Rvan's Steakhouse in Springfield. The meeting was called to order by the chairman, Dave Woods at 10:10AM.

After the pledge of allegiance, roll call of officers was taken with the following present, Chairman, Dave Woods; NFAA Director, Judy McCutcheon; northern board, Rick Knorr, Walter Erickson and Bill Berger, central board, James Anderson and Bill Mohn; southern board, Ron Whitlock, Bill Schuh and Robert Rayhel; NFAA Councilman, Robert McCutcheon. Roll call of delegates was taken with 10 delegates present.

The minutes of the last meeting was passed out to the board member in advance and Ron

Whitlock made a motion, 2nd by Bill Berger to accept as published. Motion carried.

The financial statement was accepted as printed with a motion by Bill Berger and 2nd by Jim

Anderson. Motion carried.

NFAA Director, Judy McCutcheon reported on the NFAA convention including some dates and issues voted on. Agenda items passed may be viewed at the NFAA web site. Judy will have her report ready for publication in the next bulletin. A discussion was held on Illinois presenting an agenda item for the next convention. Wally Erickson made a motion, 2nd by Ron Whitlock to add BHFS to the youth class. Motion carried. Judy will draw up an agenda and present it at the convention.

NFAA councilman had nothing further to present to the NFAA report but did answer some

questions.

The awards committee chairman, Judy McCutcheon reported that awards had been ordered. A discussion was held on the convention for 2011 and Dixie will check on the Golden Coral in Springfield and report back at the next meeting. There was no report from the RIC committee. The Bowhunting and conservation reported that they had dropped the whitetail team hunt for this year with only having one team to sign up. Ron Whitlock made a motion to drop the Pope and Young scoring requirement from the big game application. Motion carried. The youth committee announced that an indoor tournament for the youth will be held at Glisson Archery. The tournament committee report that a change has been made for the Bowhunter Rendezvous awards. IAA medals will be used instead of plaques. The target outdoor will be a 1 or 2 day event this year. The committee also noted that the Joliet Archery Club had donated the proceeds from the indoor championship and sectional championship to the IAA. After discussion it was suggested to clubs that when they bid on the championship tournaments, they consider offering more money back to the IAA, or we might consider changing the split to help keep the IAA more solvent. No action was taken. Bill Schuh from the club & membership retention committee had some questions on membership.

IAA Secretary, Dixie Garner gave a short report on some dates and requirements of charters,

bulletins deadline and the e-mail mailing.

The NASP program was discussed. The championship will be held March 27 in the Orr building in Springfield. Judy reported that 13 schools had signed up. Help will be needed for set up on March 26, time to be determined. Panther Creek had set up a challenge for bows to be donated and it was reported that 6 bows has been donated. The IAA youth fund will furnished the arrows to go along with the 6 bows. Bob McCutcheon showed the new targets that will be used for the shoot.

The next board meeting will be held July 10 following the target championship in Joliet. Robert Rayhel made a motion to hold the November meeting on November 7, 2010 at Prairie Archery 2nd by

Bill Berger.

Retired IAA life membership request was granted to Delmar and Margaret Powell on a motion by Wally Erickson, 2nd by Robert Rayhel.

A discussion was held on the vacancy of the central board rep. with no decision made.

Bill Schuh made a suggestion on having a gun raffle. After discussion Bill will type up a format and bring back to the July meeting.

Tournament bids were received and the winning bids are published in this bulletin.

Bowhunting & conservation committee member, Ron Whitlock presented the big game and outstanding kill to George Zanoni. The outdoor and indoor aggregate awards were passed out. Dave Woods presented Certificate of Appreciation to Prairie Archery, Buckskin Legacy, and Joliet Archery for their support of the IAA.

The secretary position was discussed and Dixie Garner accepted the position of another year. A \$100 expense for gas was granted and a new laptop will be purchased for Judy to handle the

championships.

Jim Anderson made a motion to adjourn, 2nd by Ron Whitlock. The meeting was adjourned at 2:30PM

Agenda Items

New rulings will take effect June 1, 2010. I only reviewed some of the more pertinent items with the delegates attending the Convention, noted below. The changes to the Constitution have been posted on the NFAA website and can be reviewed there. Please feel free to call or email me if you have questions.

PASSED: 15 SIGNATURE ITEM MS 1 - presented after other agenda items for changing the annual meeting were defeated:

RATIONALE & PROPOSED CHANGE: Bi-annual meetings would save money for the NFAA, state associations, and individual directors and also for rulebook publication expense necessitated by changes. Day-to-day business can be handled by Council with input from Directors, RIC items can be mailed to Directors for a vote as can budget issues. Passed as amended: Add the following statement: "This amendment is for a 2-year trial period to be addressed at the annual meeting in 2012."

PASSED: Constitution page 43 Submitted by Wisconsin code WI-1

RATIONALE By flighting after all scores are shot, puts every archer in order by score with no one shooting a lower score or an incomplete score and finishing above an archer with a higher overall score.

Proposed change: 2. For Outdoor Nationals, archers will be arranged in flights according to their final score and X count, whether it is a 3 day, 5 day or 3/5 day National format. For Outdoor Sectionals, archers will be arranged in flights according to their final score and X count.

3. For Indoor Nationals and Indoor Sectionals, archers will be arranged in flights according to their final score and X count.

PASSED AS AMENDED: 2. For Outdoor Nationals, archers will be arranged in flights according to their final score and X count, whether it is a 3 day, 5 day or 3/5 day National format. For Outdoor Sectionals, archers will be arranged in flights according to their final score and may include X count.

PASSED: Constitution page 43 Submitted by Southeast Section code SE-2

RATIONALE: Whether a large or small tournament, we need to go with the "Equal division of the number of archers in each flight will be maintained," and "the last flight will record a lesser number (for two flights) or an unequal number (for three or more flights) as may be required" rules as closely as possible.

Proposed change: Insert new chart showing equal number of shooters in each flight

PASSED: Constitution page 46 Submitted by Texas code TX-1 RATIONALE: We have nothing in the book for scoring Robinhoods.

Proposed change: Add paragraph in Outdoor Shooting Rules under Scoring:

9. An arrow embedded in the nock of another arrow (generally known as a Robinhood) will be scored the same as the arrow it skewered, even if it falls to the ground ad not in said target. PASSED AS AMENDED: Remove "even if it falls to the ground and not in said target."

PASSED: Constitution page 20. Submitted by Southeast Section code SE-4

Rationale: Taking office on 1 Jan and leaving office on 31 December can have an elected official waiting to take office for as long as 11 months. Office should be assumed the month following election or sooner if the office is vacant:

Proposed change: The Councilman shall take office on the first day of the month immediately following election. When the office is vacant, the Councilman shall take office immediately upon election.

PASSED: Add the 300 ft. per second rule to the 3-D rules, which should have been changed in 2009 when the revision was made. This was made effective IMMEDIATELY to take effect for the NFAA Marked and Unmarked 3D tournaments taking place in May.

PASSED: Addition to Professional Dress Code as follows: Not acceptable – jeans of any color except for Outdoor field and outdoor 3D events. Swimming suits, cut-offs and obscene or vulgar slogans or pictures on clothing. Violations to the dress code will be enforced by the Pro Executive Committee and may result in a reprimand, probation, or suspension. Violations should be brought to the Pro Chair by the Tournament Chair.

DEFEATED: Constitution page 17. Submitted by Great Lakes Section code GL-1 Rationale: The use of 15 signature items for the annual meeting is hostile to the Constitution; Directors being asked to vote on these items are not prepared to vote: having no knowledge of the consensus of their state membership on such items. See Article II Purpose: Item L Proposed change: Annual Meeting. Revise to read:

5.9 - Remove the sentence "Additional items may be placed on the agenda by resolutions signed by 15 board members present at the annual meeting, and must be in proper form". 5.13 - Remove entire item - renumber remaining items

DEFEATED: Pro items to change the scoring to score the x-ring as a '6' for professionals for the Championship Field and Hunter rounds (intent was for State, Sectional, and Outdoor Nationals). The items were brought back to the floor, discussed, and defeated for a second time. The agenda items were then brought back as amended to read "at Outdoor Nationals for a 2-year trial period". The items were defeated for a third time.

NO ACTION OR DEFEATED: Items to add longbow class, make crossbows illegal in competition, to change youth yardages and to change outdoor yardages for traditional shooters were either no action or defeated. There was no action on the item to add Bowhunter freestyle to YA, Y, C.

NO ACTION OR DEFEATED: All items to change descriptions, add definitions to Field/Hunter rounds and to change Field/Hunter rounds.

NO ACTION: Constitution page 18. Submitted by North Carolina code NC-1
Rationale: To promote the growth of the NFAA membership by utilizing Membership
Chairpersons at the State level. To collaborate and share ideas within each Section and Nation
wide. Through the sharing of different ideas, each state should be required to choose one or two
ideas or more if it is a larger state, to try in their area.

Proposed change: Duties of the Board of Directors:

11. Work with a State Membership Chairperson, appointed by them, to develop programs to acquire and expand membership programs in their state, and to provide their councilman with an annual written report of their efforts.

Duties of the Council

Shall work with the NFAA Board of Directors within his/her section to review the membership programs and results, and provide a written report of those results, and plans for the following year, at the annual meeting.

RIC Rulings

The RIC ruling for the archer who was bumped which caused his arrow to miss the target was: the arrow passed the 10-foot line and was therefore a shot arrow and the director was incorrect in allowing the archer to shoot another arrow. The Directors overturned this ruling.

All other RIC were upheld.
