Roll call of officers was taken with the following present. NFAA Director, Judy McCutcheon; northern board, Rick Knorr and Tim Ward; central board, Mike Lantz, Jim Anderson and Bill Mohn; southern board, Ron Whitlock, Bill Schuh and Tim Eller.

The minutes of the last meeting was passed out in advance and Jim Anderson made a motion, 2nd by Mike Lantz to accept as printed. The treasurer report was reviewed and Jim Anderson made a motion, 2nd by Ron Whitlock to accept.

Chairman, Robert Rayhel reported that the trailer was stocked with bows, arrows and targets. He reported that he would build new racks for the targets, and he will check on the insurance.

A discussion was held on the shooter of the year award that will be given at the convention. This award will be shaped in the state of Illinois.

- A. Any other type of Big Game Animal NOT commonly found in the territorial boundaries of the United States, but declared Big Game on an INTERNATIONAL LEVEL will be considered for an award, providing that such Big Game was taken legally and is not on the ENDANGERED SPECIES LIST of the U.S. Government, and that the PELT of said animal can legally be brought into this country.
- B. That the governing body of this Association will have the right to disqualify any such animal that does not meet the requirements listed in Paragraph A
- C. That all Big Game animals submitted for an award be submitted with substantial proof of the kill:
 - 1. That a picture of the animal and the signature of witness, warden, forest ranger, conservation officer or police officer be present on all applications.
- 2. If for any reason Paragraph C, Item 1 cannot be complied with, a letter of explanation must accompany all applications giving full details and circumstances as to why.
- 3. If you hunted with a reputable and licensed guide, a letter of acknowledgment of the taking of any Big Game will be accepted in place of the above mentioned signatures.
- D. A PICTURE MUST ACCOMPANY ALL APPLICATIONS.

BOWHUNTING FAIR CHASE RULES DEFINED:

Any animal taken under any of the following circumstances shall not be considered for any award: "YARDED' IN DEEP SNOW, HELPLESS IN WATER, HELPLESS ON ICE, HELPLESS IN TRAP, WHILE CONFINED BEHIND FENCES AS ON GAME FARMS, ETC., IN DEFIANCE OF GAME LAWS OR OUT OF SEASON. No animal shall be taken by "Jack Lighting"- shining at night from a power vehicle or power boat. Any other method considered by the N.F.A.A. or I.A.A. Bowhunting Committee to be UNSPORTSMANLIKE.

For the biggest buck or body weight contest, please attach a legal locker slip with the name of the locker of business where the animal was weighed. Field dressed weights only will be considered. Witness will verify that field dressed carcass was minus all intestines, liver, heart and lungs.

If you feel that your animal is in contention for the big buck, big bear, or outstanding kill award of the year, please enclose an official Pope and Young measurement with application

DEADLINE DATE FOR APPLICATION IS FEBRUARY This application and the associated fee must be received by February $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$.

GAME AWARDS

All Big Game will be judged by the Bowhunting committee. Team Hunt, Weight contests and Small Game speak for themselves. If necessary, call Ron Whitlock at 217-942-3377.

<u>WHITETAILL TEAM HUNT AWARD:</u> Plaques for each team member of the winning team. Scoring method is 40 points for a doe, 20 points for a buck plus 5 points per point of antlers 1 inch or longer.

OUTSTANDING KILL OF THE YEAR: (In or out of state) Outstanding Kill Plaque, name engraved on plate and George Chamberlain Pin: Gold and Blue border / This is highest ranking animal in its division as compared to highest ranking other animal in its own division. Example: Typical deer scoring 135" is higher ranking than non-typical deer scoring 150". Deer scoring 135" is higher ranking than Antelope scoring 65".

IN STATE BIG BUCK AWARD: (Antler). Guy McMiminy pin: Gold Illinois pin with IBH

<u>OUTSIDE STATE BIG GAME AWARD:</u> Guy McMininy pin: <u>Bronze Illinois pin with IBH.</u> This is highest ranked, any animal—Can also be Outstanding Kill.

<u>BIG BUCK, BIG DOE AWARD:</u> (field dressed weight). George McMininy pin; <u>Gold with green border.</u>

SECOND DEER AWARD AND ALL OTHER DEER KILLED. George Chamberlain pin: Silver with green border. This applies to 2nd antlered, 2nd body weight buck and 2nd body weight doe.

BIGGEST BLACK BEAR AWARD: George Chamberlain pin; Gold with red border.

ALL OTHER BIG GAME KILLED: George Chamberlain pin: Silver with red border. Example #1; See heading of IAA big Game application: Definition: Specifically: Any Big Game animal. Example # 2; Not winning in Outstanding or out of State, a Moose, Elk, etc.

<u>SMALL GAME AWARD.</u> George McMininy pin: <u>Gold with Green Border.</u> This applies to all legal small game. Example: Rabbits, Squirrels, and winged game (where legal).






