PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE BY LAWS

ADD 3A TO ARTICLE V OFFICERS

3A. Elected Officers are expected to attend Board of Directors meeting. An office holder may be removed from office for failure to attend at least one of the three Board of Directors meetings per elected year.

Such removal shall be at the discretion of the Board of Directors. Removal from office shall require votes for removal from at least 6 of the 10 Board members.

The IAA Board of Directors meeting was held November 9, 2014 at Garner's Archery in Roodhouse following lunch. The meeting was called to order at 12:55pm by the Chairman, Robert Rayhel.

Roll call of officers was taken with the following present. NFAA Director, Judy McCutcheon-Adams; northern board, Rick Knorr; central board, Bill Mohn; southern board, Bill Schuh, Ron Whitlock and Tim Eller.

The minutes of the last meeting was passed out in advance and Bill Mohn made a motion, 2nd by Ron Whitlock to accept as published. The Financial reports were reviewed and Ron Whitlock made a motion, 2nd by Tim Eller to accept.

A discussion was held on the agenda item to change the IAA constitution bylaws affecting the Officers. This agenda was amended and will be published in the December newsletter.

Bill Schuh gave a report on the gun raffle and stated that he was mailing out letters to members that don't belong to any club about selling tickets.

Awards committee, Judy McCutcheon-Adams reported that she will need medals for the indoor championship.

Bowhunting committee, Ron Whitlock reported that there were no teams signed up for the team hunt this year. A discussion was held on a marked 3-D tournament. Bill Mohn will check with Scheels to see if they are willing to hold a tournament and report back at the convention.

The convention date was set for March 1 and Dixie will check to see if Motel 66 is available.

The Youth committee, Bill Mohn reported that there were 29 shooters in the 4-H championship shoot in October. There was no date reported for the NASP Championship.

There was no report from the RIC committee.

Tournament dates for 2015 were set and they are listed in the coming events.

Bill Mohn reported on the US National Target Championship that may be held in Springfield in 2017. After discussion Tim Eller made a motion, 2nd by Rick Knorr to support Panther Creek and JOAD for this bid.

Chairman, Robert Rayhel made the committee appointments for 2015.

Bill Mohn suggested that we host a 900 round as a warm up using the FITA round. This will be discussed at the convention in March.

NFAA Director Judy McCutcheon-Adams hadn't received the NFAA agenda items to report to the board.

Ron Whitlock suggested that we consider having the state field shoots on a 14 target course. A discussion followed and this will be discussed at the convention.

Tim Eller made a motion to adjourn 2nd by Judy McCutcheon-Adams. The meeting adjourned at 3PM.

IAA Board of Directors and the members that were present at the convention in March have decided to hold another Gun Raffle to raise money for the organization. This will enable the organization to do more things to promote itself and the sport that we all love.

Ticket Prices are \$15.00 each and Tickets go on sale late August.

First drawing will be in January of 2015. We have to sell 600 tickets before the drawings will start. If we do not sell at least 600 tickets, it will become a 50/50 drawing.

Guns will not be purchased until after each drawing. Winner may want cash instead of the gun for that month. If the winner chooses the gun, there may be a delay in delivery of the gun due to some shortages from manufacturers, according to the firearms dealer we are working with.

Only 2000 tickets will be printed which will increase the odds of winning. Drawn ticket will go back into the bucket for the next drawing so 1 person has the potential to win all 12 guns for an investment of \$15.00.

Bill Mohn and Bill Schuh again graciously agreed at the convention to administer the raffle for the IAA. Club contacts or members contact Bill Mohn for tickets.

Club contact will distribute tickets to club members. They know the members and can better control tickets and money. Club contact will collect the ticket stubs and \$\$ or checks. Please make checks payable to IAA for amount collected.

Seller puts their name on the back of the ticket stub that they sell. For every 5 stubs that you sell, seller will be put into the drawing for one of five \$100 prizes. Each member needs to turn in their sold ticket stubs by the 15th of the month for the next month's drawing.

Tickets can be sold to non-Illinois residents. IL residents will require a FOID card to accept a gun. Non IL residents will need to make delivery arrangements with their local FFL gun dealer to receive any guns won.

To make this a success, we will need every member's help. The first time we had the gun raffle a few of us weren't sure it would work. I was one of them. IAA Raffle Ticket Selling Tips

1. Contact your local club raffle contact or Bill Mohn to obtain tickets to sell. Bill Mohn, call 217-725-0836.
2. Since the tickets cost \$15, carry a few \$5 bills so you can make change for \$20 bills.
3. Ask friends, family and co-workers if they like guns and gun raffles. If they say "no", then ask them if they like cash. There is a cash option for each raffle if they don't want a gun. Show them the back of the tickets for the list of guns and cash options.
4. Explain that these tickets are for 12 raffles at \$1.25 per raffle. The winning tickets go back in the cage for the next drawing so all tickets are in all 12 raffles.
5. Have the buyer fill out the left portion of ticket so we can contact them. Tear off the right portion of ticket and give to the buyer so they can see what is being given away each month.
6. Be sure to put your name on the back of the ticket stub as IAA member. For every 5 tickets you sell, you get your name entered once for 5 drawings for \$100 each. The more tickets you sell the more chances you have of getting drawn for the \$500 cash. Everyone can sell at least 5 tickets and get in on this drawing.

Notes:

Some people may ask how they get their gun if they live out of state. If people live out of state or don't want to pick up their gun at our dealer in Springfield, IL, they can have the gun shipped from our dealer to an FFL gun dealer near them. Then they can pick up their gun at their local dealer.

Some people may ask if they need a FOID to buy tickets. They do not need a FOID to buy tickets. If they are a winner and live in Illinois and want a gun instead of cash, then they will need a FOID. Out of state winners do not need a FOID.



GAME AWARDS

All Big Game will be judged by the Bowhunting committee. Team Hunt, Weight contests and Small Game speak for themselves. If necessary, call Ron Whitlock at 217-942-3377.

WHITETAIL TEAM HUNT AWARD: Plaques for each team member of the winning team. Scoring method is 40 points for a doe, 20 points for a buck plus 5 points per point of antlers 1 inch or longer.

OUTSTANDING KILL OF THE YEAR: (In or out of state) Outstanding Kill Plaque, name engraved on plate and George Chamberlain Pin: Gold and Blue border / This is highest ranking animal in its division as compared to highest ranking other animal in its own division. Example: Typical deer scoring 135" is higher ranking than non-typical deer scoring 150". Deer scoring 135" is higher ranking than Antelope scoring 65".

IN STATE BIG BUCK AWARD: (Antler). Guy McMiminy pin: Gold Illinois pin with IBH

OUTSIDE STATE BIG GAME AWARD: Guy McMiminy pin: Bronze Illinois pin with IBH. This is highest ranked, any animal—Can also be Outstanding Kill.

BIG BUCK, BIG DOE AWARD: (field dressed weight). George McMiminy pin; Gold with green border.

SECOND DEER AWARD AND ALL OTHER DEER KILLED. George Chamberlain pin: Silver with green border. This applies to 2nd antlered, 2nd body weight buck and 2nd body weight doe.

BIGGEST BLACK BEAR AWARD: George Chamberlain pin; Gold with red border.

ALL OTHER BIG GAME KILLED: George Chamberlain pin: Silver with red border. Example #1; See heading of IAA big Game application: Definition: Specifically: Any Big Game animal. Example # 2; Not winning in Outstanding or out of State, a Moose, Elk, etc.

SMALL GAME AWARD. George McMiminy pin: Gold with Green Border. This applies to all legal small game. Example: Rabbits, Squirrels, and winged game (where legal).

A. Any other type of Big Game Animal NOT commonly found in the territorial boundaries of the United States, but declared Big Game on an INTERNATIONAL LEVEL will be considered for an award, providing that such Big Game was taken legally and is not on the ENDANGERED SPECIES LIST of the U.S. Government, and that the PELT of said animal can legally be brought into this country.

B. That the governing body of this Association will have the right to disqualify any such animal that does not meet the requirements listed in Paragraph A

C. That all Big Game animals submitted for an award be submitted with substantial proof of the kill:

1. That a picture of the animal and the signature of witness, warden, forest ranger, conservation officer or police officer be present on all applications.

2. If for any reason Paragraph C, Item 1 cannot be complied with, a letter of explanation must accompany all applications giving full details and circumstances as to why.

3. If you hunted with a reputable and licensed guide, a letter of acknowledgment of the taking of any Big Game will be accepted in place of the above mentioned signatures.

D. A PICTURE MUST ACCOMPANY ALL APPLICATIONS.

BOWHUNTING FAIR CHASE RULES DEFINED:

Any animal taken under any of the following circumstances shall not be considered for any award:

“YARDED” IN DEEP SNOW, HELPLESS IN WATER, HELPLESS ON ICE, HELPLESS IN TRAP, WHILE CONFINED BEHIND FENCES AS ON GAME FARMS, ETC., IN DEFIANCE OF GAME LAWS OR OUT OF SEASON. No animal shall be taken by “Jack Lighting”- shining at night from a power vehicle or power boat. Any other method considered by the N.F.A.A. or I.A.A. Bowhunting Committee to be UNSPORTSMANLIKE




