Archery season is underway and if you've been successful in harvesting your deer already, congratulations! For those who are still getting ready to go, hope you have a safe, enjoyable, and successful hunt.

The November Board of Directors meeting was held November 1, 2015 at 1 P.M at Sheels in Springfield. Robert Rayhel was retained as Chairman of the Board, and called the meeting to order. Three new officers were welcomed, Kathy Pindell, Don Craig, and Craig Olson.

The Board would like to thank Jim Anderson, Tim Ward, Bill Mohn, and Bill Schuh for their many years on the board. Their devotion, time, and hard work have kept the IAA going. Thank you all for your contributions!

The IAA convention will be held March 6, 2016 at Motel 66 Hotel and Convention Center in Springfield.

An auction for a Taurus Model 66 .357 Mag, stainless steel, black rubber grips, 7 shot revolver will be taking place at the convention. The opening bid for the gun is \$472. Bidders must be present and have a valid Illinois FOID card. This gun is available from the July gun raffle when the ticket winner opted to take the cash.



The Great Lakes Outdoor Sectional may be hosted by any IAA club in Illinois beginning in 2017 and may host it for 3 years if desired. A minimum 28 field is required, with an additional 14 if possible, and adequate parking and food available. Written bids must be submitted to Sara Rayhel, IAA Secretary, 13984 E 1425th Ave., Robinson, IL 62454 by March 1, 2016. The board will vote on the bids in closed session at the convention.

The IAA Board of Directors meeting was held November 1, 2015 at Sheel's in Springfield. The meeting was called to order at 1:05pm by Chairman, Robert Rayhel.

Roll call of officers was taken with the following present. NFAA Director, Judy McCutcheon-Adams; IAA Chairman, Robert Rayhel; northern board, Rick Knorr; central board, Don Craig, Roger Nieders, and Kathy Pindell; southern board, Tim Eller, Craig Olson, and Ron Whitlock. Others present were Rick Adams and Pat Whitlock.

The minutes of the last meeting were passed out in advance and Judy McCutcheon-Adams made a motion, 2nd by Ron Whitlock to accept as published. Motion passed. The Financial reports were reviewed and Tim Eller made a motion, 2nd by Don Craig to accept. Motion passed.

A discussion was held on the Bowhunter Jamboree marked yardage 3D held in September. A motion was made by Ron Whitlock, 2nd by Craig Olson to add a Spring Bowhunter Jamboree to be held anytime in May. Motion passed. Clubs will bid at convention in March to host the shoot. Spring Openers are not well attended and clubs will decide at the convention whether to continue the shoot.

A picture of an example of a belt buckle for Shooter of the Year award was shown. Two buckles would be needed at the 2017 convention for the male and female with the highest combined scores of 2016 State Indoor, State Field, and State Target. Pros scores will be based on the same total possible points as amateurs, disregarding the extra points for X ring. Price and design for the buckles will be researched.

Awards committee, Judy McCutcheon-Adams reported she had received the state championship patches. State award pins and bowhunting jamboree patches and pins have also been received.

Bowhunting committee, Ron Whitlock reported that there were no teams signed up for the team hunt this year. If a member has a successful bowhunt this year, including crossbow, be sure and fill out the application in the bulletin for a game award and send to Ron Whitlock. There are many types of pins available.

The convention date was set for March 6 at Route 66 Hotel and Conference Center in Springfield.

Youth committee, Tim Eller said the NASP state tournament will be held April 2 at fairgrounds in Springfield. A table for IAA/NFAA promotional materials was suggested. Materials have been requested from NFAA by Judy McCutcheon-Adams. A motion by Ron Whitlock, 2nd by Tim Eller to take funds from youth account to buy NASP patches to sell at the tournament with the proceeds from the sale of the patches to be deposited back into the youth fund. Motion passed. Discussion was continued on the progress of purchasing netting out of the youth fund. Craig Olson reported the 4-H State shoot will be Sept. 10, 2016 at Panther Creek Bowhunters.

RIC committee went over the new constitution rule that board directors must attend 1/3 of the annual meetings.

Membership & Club Retention- state IAA dues must be paid by U.S. Archers in order to participate in state shoots. Robert Rayhel encouraged promoting another vote by the NFAA directors to allow NFAA members to be affiliated with 2 state organizations at the same time.

Chairman, Robert Rayhel made the committee appointments for 2016.

Tournament dates for 2016 were set and are listed in the coming events.

The Great Lakes Outdoor Sectional may be hosted by any IAA club in Illinois beginning in 2017 and may host it for 3 years if desired. A minimum 28 field is required, with an additional 14 if possible, and adequate parking and food available. Written bids must be submitted to Sara Rayhel by March 1, 2016. IAA Board of Directors and the members that were present at the convention in March have decided to hold another Gun Raffle to raise money for the organization. This will enable the organization to do more things to promote itself and the sport that we all love.

Ticket Prices are \$15.00 each and Tickets go on sale late August.

First drawing will be in January of 2015. We have to sell 600 tickets before the drawings will start. If we do not sell at least 600 tickets, it will become a 50/50 drawing.

Guns will not be purchased until after each drawing. Winner may want cash instead of the gun for that month. If the winner chooses the gun, there may be a delay in delivery of the gun due to some shortages from manufacturers, according to the firearms dealer we are working with.

Only 2000 tickets will be printed which will increase the odds of winning. Drawn ticket will go back into the bucket for the next drawing so 1 person has the potential to win all 12 guns for an investment of \$15.00.

Bill Mohn and Bill Schuh again graciously agreed at the convention to administer the raffle for the IAA. Club contacts or members contact Bill Mohn for tickets.

Club contact will distribute tickets to club members. They know the members and can better control tickets and money. Club contact will collect the ticket stubs and \$\$ or checks. Please make checks payable to IAA for amount collected.

Seller puts their name on the back of the ticket stub that they sell. For every 5 stubs that you sell, seller will be put into the drawing for one of five \$100 prizes. Each member needs to turn in their sold ticket stubs by the 15th of the month for the next month's drawing.

Tickets can be sold to non-Illinois residents. IL residents will require a FOID card to accept a gun. Non IL residents will need to make delivery arrangements with their local FFL gun dealer to receive any guns won.

To make this a success, we will need every member's help. The first time we had the gun raffle a few of us weren't sure it would work. I was one of them. These two members and the people who helped sell the tickets more than proved us wrong. The first raffle proceeds enabled the IAA to function for the last 3 years. It's what we used to purchase the State Championship trophies which cost the IAA approximately \$2000.00 for last year (2013). It will be the same for this year (2014). So please take a few minutes and think about this, then get with either Bill Mohn or Bill Schuh and have them send some tickets to you. We need your help.

IAA Raffle Ticket Selling Tips

1. Contact your local club raffle contact or Bill Mohn to obtain tickets to sell. Bill Mohn, call 217-725-0836.
2. Since the tickets cost \$15, carry a few \$5 bills so you can make change for \$20 bills.
3. Ask friends, family and co-workers if they like guns and gun raffles. If they say “no”, then ask them if they like cash. There is a cash option for each raffle if they don’t want a gun. Show them the back of the tickets for the list of guns and cash options.
4. Explain that these tickets are for 12 raffles at \$1.25 per raffle. The winning tickets go back in the cage for the next drawing so all tickets are in all 12 raffles.
5. Have the buyer fill out the left portion of ticket so we can contact them. Tear of the right portion of ticket and give to the buyer so they can see what is being given away each month.
6. Be sure to put your name on the back of the ticket stub as IAA member. For every 5 tickets you sell, you get your name entered once for 5 drawings for \$100 each. The more tickets you sell the more chances you have of getting drawn for the \$500 cash. Everyone can sell at least 5 tickets and get in on this drawing.
7. Mail ticket stubs and a check for the total sold to Bill Schuh, 7811 Dustman Road, Worden, IL 62097. Make checks payable to IAA or Illinois Archery Association.

Notes:

Some people may ask how they get their gun if they live out of state. If people live out of state or don’t want to pick up their gun at our dealer in Springfield, IL, they can have the gun shipped from our dealer to an FFL gun dealer near them. Then they can pick up their gun at their local dealer.

Some people may ask if they need a FOID to buy tickets. They do not need a FOID to buy tickets. If they are a winner and live in Illinois and want a gun instead of cash, then they will need a FOID. Out of state winners do not need a FOID.


