FROM SARA'S SPOT:

The **IAA Indoor State Championship** was held in March with devoted archers and new participants shooting. These archers will be eligible to compete for the Shooter of the Year and silver belt buckle for high scoring male and female from the combined scores of Indoor, State Field at Panther Creek Aug. 13-14, and State Target at Pekin Archers Sept. 10-11. Thank you to Presleys Outdoor for hosting our event this year. Winners of the gift certificates were Bella Ordner, Travis Brown, and Bill Kingore. Results are in the bulletin, website and Facebook.

A newly rebuilt Kentucky International Convention Center was home to **NFAA Indoor Nationals at Louisville**. Over 1500 shooters from all 50 states plus archers from Canada, Denmark and the Netherlands competed. On Saturday, history was made when Tanja Gellenthien, Paige Pearce and Liko Arreola all scored 600-120Xs. Tanja won the shoot off for the Freestyle Professional Female championship title and Utah pro, Kyle Douglas, collected his third consecutive Indoor National Championship beating 15 other perfect shooters. 

Board of Directors Meeting

The IAA Board of Directors meeting was held March 27, 2022 at Northfield Inn and Conference Center in Springfield. The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Michael Clary at 10:33 A.M.

Roll call of officers was taken with the following present; NFAA Director, Robert Rayhel; Chairman, Mike Clary; Northern board, Rick Knorr and Bill Kingore; Central board, Don Craig and Roger Nieders; Southern board Judy McCutcheon-Adams. Board members Otto Hrad, Kathy Pindell, Patrick Eller, and Colleen Dracos were absent.

The minutes of the last meeting were distributed to the board members in advance. Motion to accept the minutes by Judy McCutcheon-Adams, 2nd by Bill Kingore. Minutes were accepted. The financial statements were accepted as published by a motion from Bill Kingore, 2nd by Rick Knorr. Motion carried.

Director Robert Rayhel reported on information from the NFAA that the Illinois Archery Association has been renewed as the only authorized official governing association for NFAA for Illinois.

A list of ideas was received from a board member prior to the meeting. Mike Clary addressed each item and discussion followed. Date for State Indoor was set for March 4-5, 2023. A marked 3D State Championship was discussed.

In old business, adult and junior fees were raised at last meeting, but family rate was not addressed. The vote on a motion by Don Craig, 2nd by Judy McCutcheon-Adams keeps the family fee at \$90.

In new business, the State Target will be held on Sept. 11 and 12 at Pekin Archers. State Field at Panther Creek was discussed and it was decided to leave it as a 2 day event so archers would shoot more than 28 targets for their entry fee. Don suggested a 3 part series including Marked 3-D.

Two applications were received for the Big Game Award. Terry Wunderle's buck was determined the winner by the board with the higher Pope & Young score of 142 compared to John Thomas' 137 3/8. Measures will be taken for the Big Game and the Barebow plaques to be returned to IAA.
